The ‘Revolutionary’ Jesus - Small Group Questions

Sermon reflection question:

1. What is your biggest take away from this week’s sermon?

Getting to know you question:

2. Who was your biggest “Idol” growing up? What about them attracted you?

Into the Bible questions:

3. When you hear the word ‘revolutionary’ what is the first thing that comes to your mind? Is it a positive or negative image? Why?

4. As Christians, Jesus does not want to make a “better” form of you. He wants to **radically** change your life. What things in your life has Jesus radically changed? How did these changes happen?

5. In your opinion, what does a radically different life look like? How is that different from what your life looks like right now?

6. Read Matthew 5:13-16. Jesus describes Christians as salt and light. In what ways are you distinctive from the culture around you?

7. After reading these verses, would you describe yourself as salty? How is God using you as a preservative in your world? Are there places you have lost your flavor?

8. How about light? Would you say your light shines bright or is it hidden? What places need God's light through you?

9. As our King, Jesus came to serve, not to be served. This was obviously very radical in his time. Are you currently involved in service to others? In what way? How has serving others impacted your life and the people around you?

Application question:

10. The Holy Spirit **IS** calling you to radically change certain things in your life right now. Write down then discuss one of those things.
